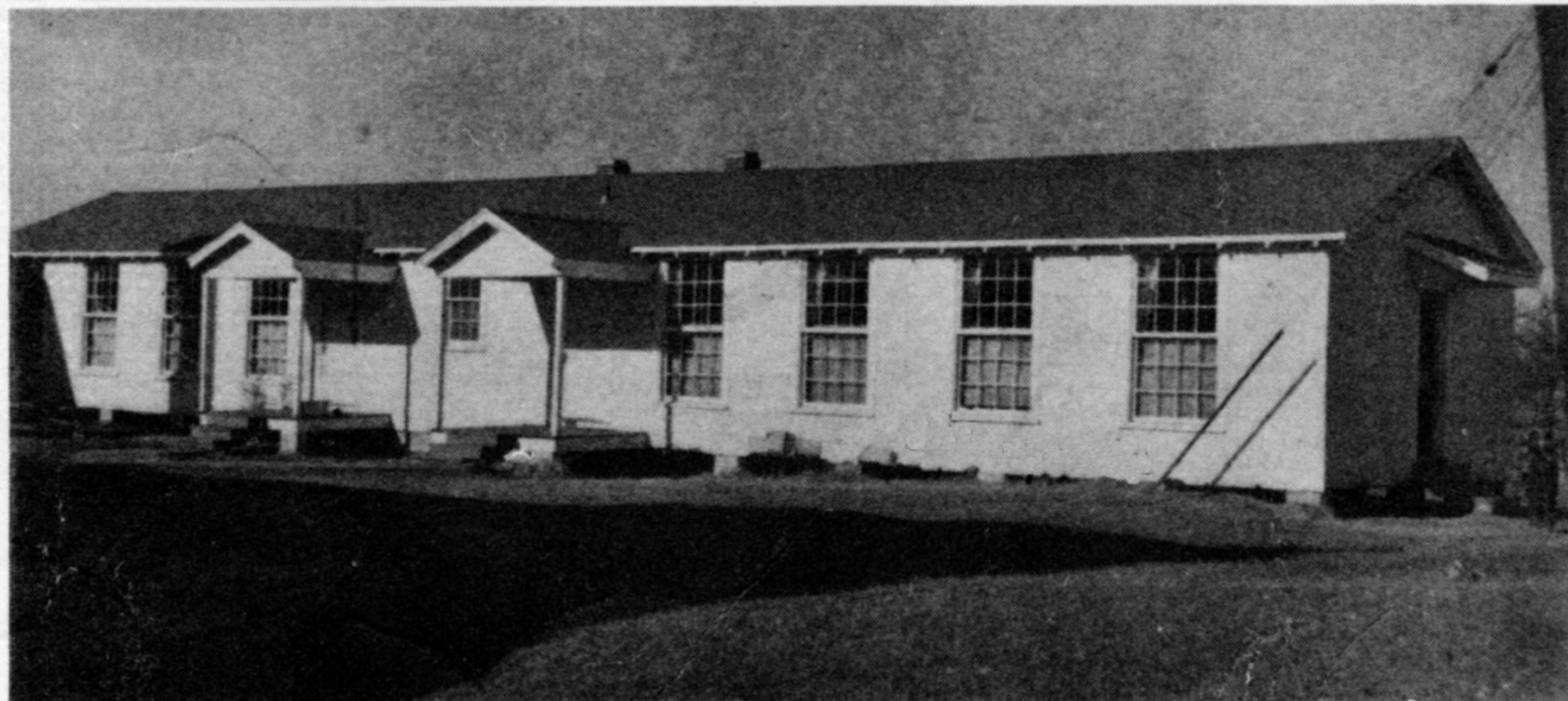
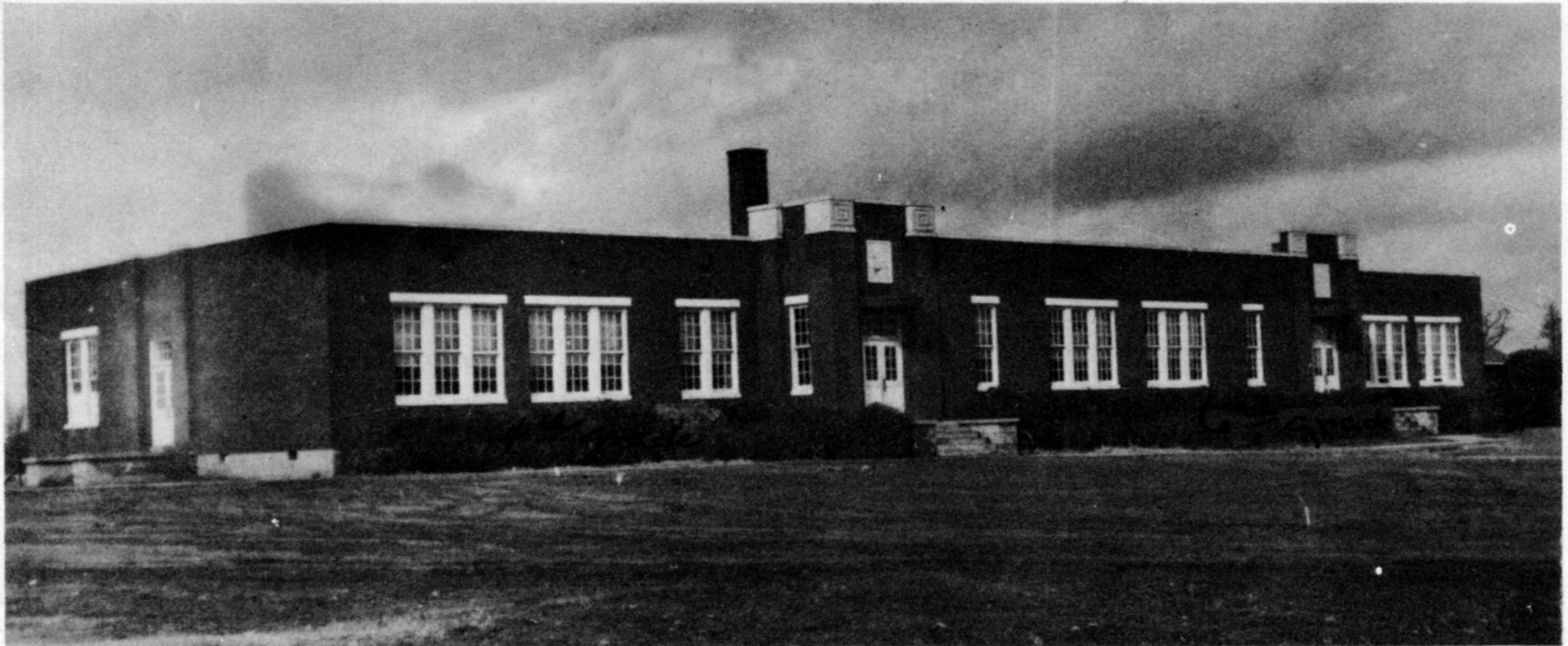
# School Board
