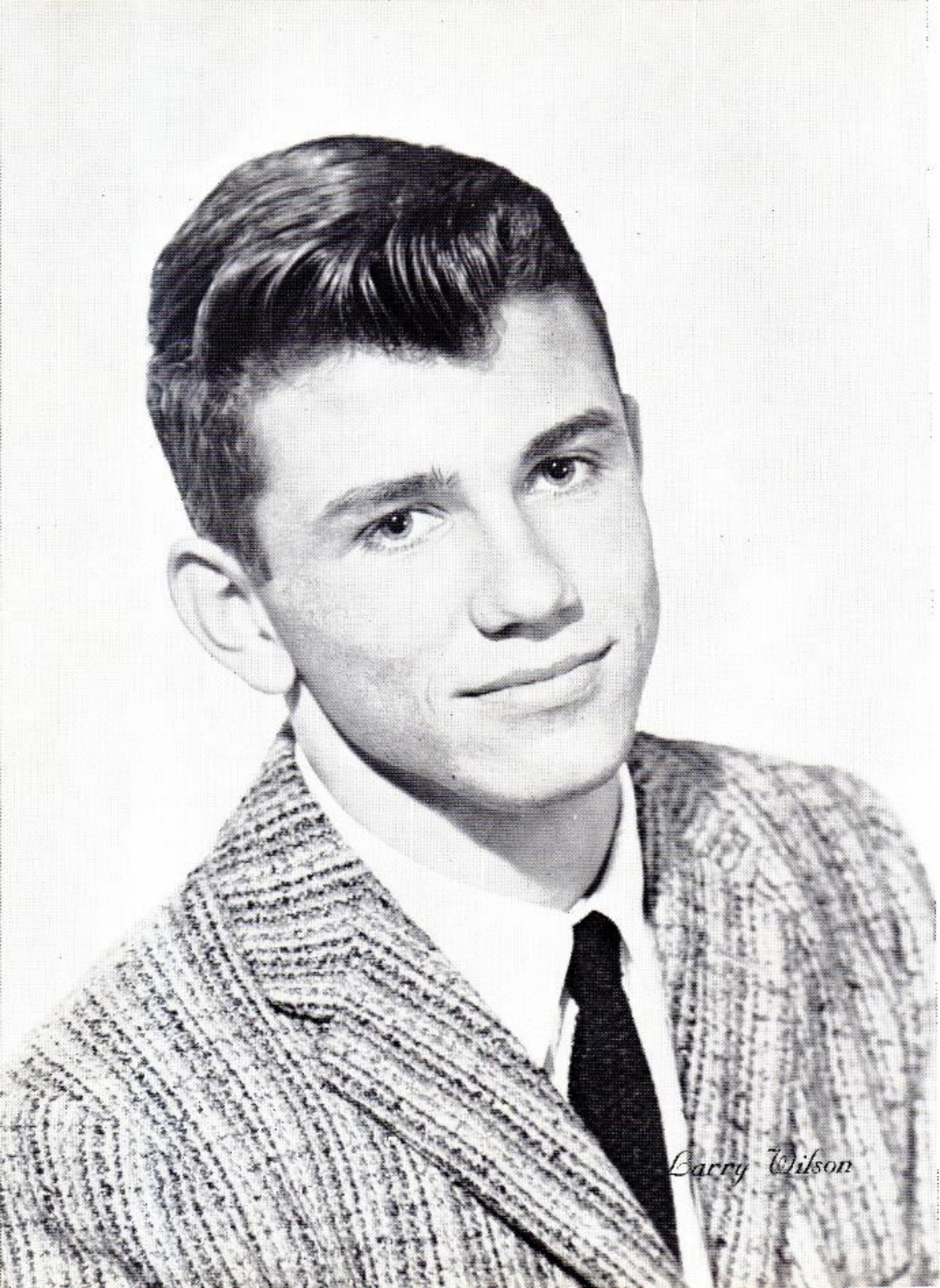
It was, nevertheless, a great deal of fun. On behalf, of Dick and Jerry, I thank you for this privilege.
