The big aluminum letters tell what we are. The workman put this up in early fall.

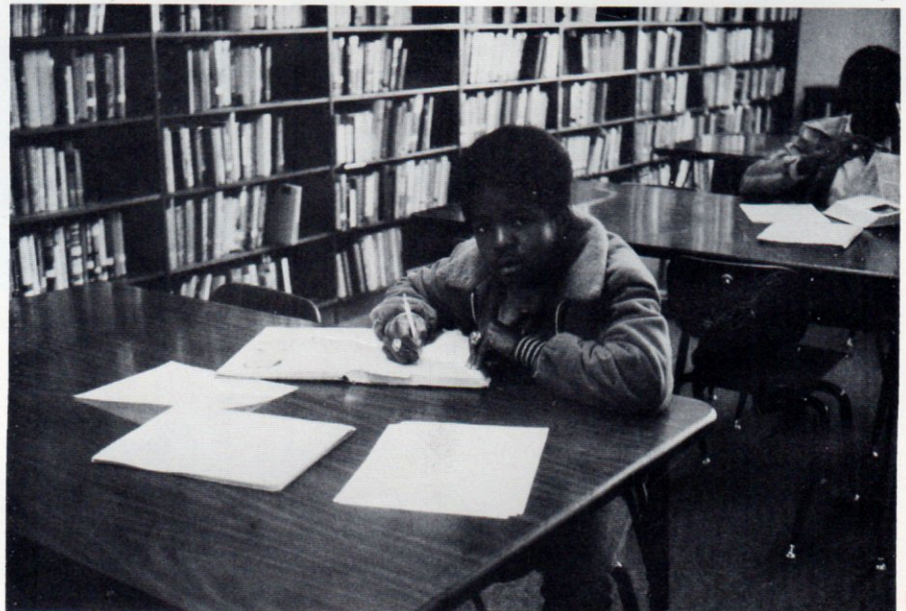


The sign tells what we are doing.

It was Christmas in the office of the superintendent.



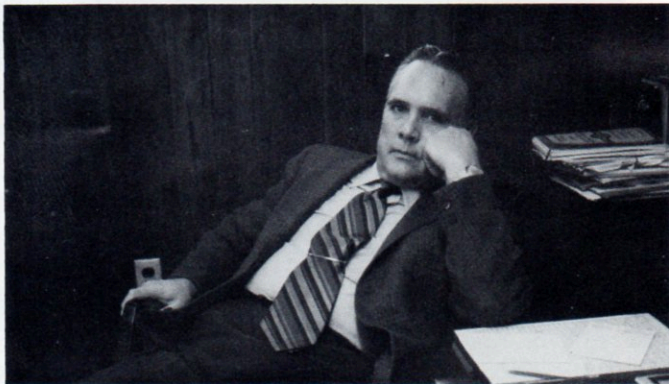


It took a lot of just meditating to plan for a district with 2100 students and almost 200 employees. A man must think if all problems are to be met and handled with any degree of success.
